KEY RESPONSIBILITIES

- Work safely at all times

- Take your training seriously; learn how to operate equipment and complete tasks with the highest degree of safety
- Complete tasks and assignments with quality, over quantity

- Be aware of your equipment and how it affects golfers. Turn it off, or stay clear of play
- Be aware of your voice, its volume and your topic of conversation; in the presence of golfers, limit volume and conversation
- Converse with Members and Guests in a kind manner:
 - Ask them if they are enjoying their round
 - o If a member introduces someone as a guest say: "Welcome to Hazeltine"
 - As golfers leave your area, wish them a nice day, or nice round
- Immediately relay any questions or comments from Members, Guests or other club employees to a superior
